This two-day workshop is designed for those interested in conducting drinking water quality testing as part of the implementation, monitoring or evaluation of access to safe and affordable drinking water. The workshop offers instruction on using portable test kits for testing microbiological parameters of drinking water. The class will focus on interpreting and reporting water quality data and more.
