Some of our Accomplishments

- Initiated projects in 12 villages and 25 schools in Nepal.
- Built latrines in 2 schools including one in a Leper community.
- Hosted workshops that trained over 200 volunteers in the creation of water filters and sanitation methods.
- Worked to bring handwashing stations to Navajo Nation.
- Brought latrines and handwashing stations to households, health centers and government schools in Cambodia.
- Working with Rotary Clubs in Lebanon, we have helped bring clean water to an estimated 600,000 Lebanese and Syrian students in 1,000+ schools.
